



Job Title: Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner

The Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner provides psychiatric evaluation and care to patients for any existing or newly diagnosed mental illness which interferes with patients' chemical dependence treatment.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performs comprehensive psychiatric examination, and records in patient chart with initial diagnosis
- Makes recommendation to treatment team for patient management plans
- Makes medication and therapy recommendations, records progress notes, and assists planning of continuity of care
- Performs follow up visits with updates in diagnosis and medications, as needed, assesses effect and/or side effects of medications and documents progress notes as needed
- Instructs and counsels patients regarding compliance with prescribed medication regimens, and addiction treatment
- Preparation and education of patients and family members for discharge medications and instructions
- Pre-Admission clearance for patients with psychiatric symptoms and Pre-Admission Interviews when indicated and in the absence of the Psychiatrist
- Evaluation and treatment of psychiatric emergencies, including response to codes

- Emergency evaluation of suicidal patients and direction of appropriate status and precautions
- Referral of unstable patients to appropriate psychiatric facilities
- Individual case assignments, case conferences, treatment team meetings, crisis intervention, educational presentations for staff and patients when indicated, and additional duties assigned by the psychiatry director/CEO
- Participates in Performance Improvement Initiatives
- Other duties as required
