



Family Nurse Practitioner Residency Training Program

The NP Residency class begins September 2018.

This 12-month program, in New York, will provide intensive training on both the clinical complexity of family practice in the safety net setting and on a high-performance, PCMH model for primary care with significant rural/migrant experience. The program is specifically intended for new Family Nurse Practitioners who are committed to practice careers as Primary Care Providers in the challenging setting of community health centers and other safety net settings. The program structure includes precepted primary care sessions, specialty rotations, mentored independent clinics, didactic sessions and quality improvement.

Qualifications

Applicants must be recent graduates (within 24 months) of a Masters or DNP program, and certified or board eligible as an FNP and licensed in NY, with a stated commitment to practice as a primary care provider in a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) or other safety net setting. The residency is a full-time, 12-month salaried position with benefits. There is a one-year employment commitment after completion of the program. Bilingual English-Spanish candidates preferred.
