

# Course: NYS Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT)

Montefiore Hudson Valley Collaborative (MHVC) is introducing an instructor-led training on SBIRT. Screening, Brief intervention, and Referral to treatment (SBIRT). SBIRT is a comprehensive, integrated, public health approach that provides opportunities for early intervention before more severe consequences occur. Evidencebased tools that are demonstrated to be valid and reliable in identifying individuals with problem use or at risk for a Substance Use Disorder (SUD) must be used. This training is part of MHVC's cross project training strategy to help build patient-centered self-management support skills and is beneficial to social work practice.
