

Course: Foundations of Motivational Interviewing

Montefiore Hudson Valley Collaborative (MHVC) is offering multiple instructor-led training on Foundations of Motivational Interviewing in 2018. This training is part of MHVC’s cross project training strategy to help build patient-centered self-management support skills.

About This Training

Motivational Interviewing (MI) is a collaborative conversation style to strengthen a person’s own motivation and commitment to change. It is designed to strengthen personal motivation for and commitment to a specific goal by eliciting and exploring the person’s own reasons for change within an atmosphere of acceptance and compassion.

By the end of this training, the learner will:

- Describe MI and the four processes
- Discuss Spirit of MI
- Understand MI core skills (OARS)
- Recognize change talk and how to respond to change talk
- Understand how to deal with resistance
- Understand how to apply “Ask-tell-ask” during patient interactions

- Care management staff
- Patient care navigators
- Health educators
- Case support roles
- Mental health providers including social workers who provide direct service, supervision, and administrative oversight
