

Course: NYS Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT)

Montefiore Hudson Valley Collaborative (MHVC) is introducing an instructor-led training on SBIRT. Screening, Brief intervention, and Referral to treatment (SBIRT). SBIRT is a comprehensive, integrated, public health approach that provides opportunities for early intervention before more severe consequences occur. Evidence-based tools that are demonstrated to be valid and reliable in identifying individuals with problem use or at risk for a Substance Use Disorder (SUD) must be used. This training is part of MHVC's cross project training strategy to help build patient-centered self-management support skills and is beneficial to social work practice.

About This Training

How does SBIRT work?

- SBIRT incorporates screening for all types of substance use with brief, tailored feedback and advice.
- SBIRT can be performed in a variety of settings. Screening does not have to be performed by a physician.
- Simple feedback on risky behavior can be one of the most important influences on patient behavior and change.
