Under general supervision of the Program Coordinator, the Licensed Bilingual Clinician provides mental health and/or dual diagnosis treatment services to persons in the community having psychiatric and substance use diagnoses and requiring services offered by a licensed mental health facility. Other responsibilities include providing treatment in various modalities, including individual, family, and group therapy for ongoing treatment cases; conducting comprehensive intake assessment and developing written treatment plan with the client (collaborative documentation) in compliance with OMH regulations; monitoring and updating the treatment plan quarterly and working with client to fulfill the goals of the treatment plan; and actively collaborating with DSS throughout the client's treatment.

The ideal candidate must possess a Master's degree in Social Work from an accredited school of social work and have a license (LMSW or LCSW) to practice social work in New York State issued by the State Education Department. Must have thorough knowledge of modern principles and techniques of social work and therapeutic interventions with individuals and families. Training and supervision in working with Dual Diagnosis and other evidence-based practices is provided. Please send cover letter with your resume.
