

Course: Disrupting Everyday Bias

Montefiore Hudson Valley Collaborative (MHVC) in collaboration with Cook Ross proudly presents multiple instructor led Disrupting Everyday Bias trainings. About This Training

Participants will receive skills to disrupt the impact of bias in their interactions, behaviors and decision-making by implementing Cook Ross’ PAUSE. To complete the PAUSE model, participants consider different actions they can take to disrupt bias. In small groups, participants identify biases in key work situations within the areas of talent, culture, and external relations. Then, participants brainstorm and commit to specific strategies they will use to disrupt biases.

By the end of this training, the learner will:

- Explore how bias functions in the brain and its impact on decision-making
- Examine how experiences and identities shape our biases
- Practice the PAUSE model and perspective-taking to disrupt biases
- Commit to implement strategies for disrupting bias in key work situation
